We host several community fundraisers to help spread awareness, grow community involvement and raise necessary funds to support the operations of The Light House.


The Light House rebuilds lives with compassion by providing shelter, job training, and services to prevent homelessness and empower people as they transition toward employment, housing and self-sufficiency.

2022 Light House Updates

- The Light House typically serves over 2,000 community members in need each year. Due to the Covid-19 Crisis, we have been consistently serving 40% more clients since the crisis began.
- In 2021, we provided emergency and transitional housing for 189 individuals including 25 children.
- In 2021, we successfully moved over 102 shelter residents and homeless community clients into safe permanent housing.
- Our Safe Harbour Resource Center serves neighbors who are unsheltered, chronically homeless, or at risk of homelessness—providing services to over 960 individuals in 2021.
- We have graduated 450 students from our B.E.S.T.
 Employment Training Program since 2012.
- Since the start of the COVID-19 crisis, the number of households we serve through our pantry programs alone has increased by more than 170%.
- In 2021, we distributed over 270,000 pounds of healthy perishable and nonperishable items to food-insecure neighbors through our pantry programs.
